Term 3 fundraisers

With the disruption of the Covid-19 pandemic effectively wiping out Term 2, we now have our two biggest fundraisers of the year occurring in Term 3. They are the Unit Raffle and the Waterfront Marathon.

Raffle

Tickets for the annual raffle have been distributed to cadets at the last two parade nights for them to start selling. Each ticket costs \$2, or a book of 10 costs \$20. Cadets have been issued 2 books (\$40) to start with. More are available once these have been sold.

Prizes are listed on the reverse side of the tickets and include a helicopter flight, Bunnings voucher, New World Orewa gift basket, golf round for 4 at Whangaparaoa Golf Club, family entry to Silverdale Adventure park, voucher for Electrical work, and some café and restaurant vouchers.

All prizes have been donated and we are very thankful to these local businesses for their support. If we can sell all the tickets, we will bring in \$6,000 less the ticket printing costs of \$750. This is a huge boost for the unit.

So please encourage your cadet to try to sell as many of these tickets as possible to friends, family, neighbours and other associates. Please make sure all ticket butts have the purchasers name and phone number of them, so we can contact them if they win!

The more tickets we can sell, the more funds we will have available to discount future activity costs for your cadets, making them more affordable for you. A committee member will be available at all parade nights to collect ticket money and ticket butts. An added incentive is that we have a 2nd helicopter flight available as a prize to the cadet who sells the most tickets! Super exciting opportunity for them.

Prizes will be drawn at the Unit Dine-in evening on Monday 21st September at the RSA.



Auckland Waterfront Marathon

This is our second big fundraiser for Term 3 and was deferred from 5th April 2020 when the country was in lockdown. Now scheduled for the weekend of 19th and 20th September, our Unit has been asked to play a bigger role at the Marathon, and in return we will be paid \$5,000 (twice what we were due to get in April).

We really need the support of every cadet and every cadet's parent to make this happen. The marshalling and water stations work at the marathon is not hard work for us to do, and it is an easy way to bring in such a great amount of money for the Unit.

Please make sure you secure these dates in your calendar now, as it is imperative that all cadets (& at least one parent or guardian) give their help to the unit for this event.
